Mountain Top Explorium is pleased to offer child-care organizations and elementary school classrooms science workshop opportunities in the 22/23 school year. Workshops include a variety of STEAM activities as well as take home projects, planned and implemented by MTE staff.

Each year MTE seeks grant funding from community partners to provide Outreach workshops at no cost to teachers. MTE expects these funds to be available again, however at this time they are still pending. In efforts to get your classroom on the books, we are taking reservations for the 2022/23 school year. Each workshop is \$250 per class, up to 30 children. MTE will send an email out 1 week prior to workshop date to confirm whether the cost will be covered by grant funding or is the responsibility of the school.

Workshops can be facilitated indoors or outdoors. MTE will set up inside your classroom for the science workshop/demonstration. Enough floor space for each child to sit and have space in front of them is recommended. Outdoor workshops are weather dependent and may require children to dress warmly to attend a 1 hour workshop. Rescheduling due to weather is OK.
